Virtual Variety Show 2021 Performer Guidelines

- 1. Most Acts probably will be solo ones, this 'Covid' year, and if performed in a group, must demonstrate social distancing or be family members living in the same household.
- 2. Each entry should reveal an interesting activity enjoyed throughout this COVID -19 isolation time.
- 3. All ages are most welcome to participate!
- 4. The performer will submit their 'Act' online (see #6). A photo of the person (entering the show) should be in the video. Please film your act in landscape mode. Note that we will not be using any formal names online for either children or adults unless you have specifically requested it. Acts may include a poem, an instrumental piece played, a dance/song, a craft project on the go, a garage being cleaned out, a book being read, a book review etc.
- 5. A video is to be max 3-4 min in length.
- 6. Please submit your 'Intention to Participate' form by March 12, 2021 to virtualvariety2021@gmail.com.

Your 'Act' must be submitted by the deadline of Fri. March 26, 2021 and given to a Drop Box using this specific link on the web: https://www.dropbox.com/request/HeKt1lHiK4T8mbW U401i

Eventually, your Act will be part of Virtual Variety Show 2021 to be aired on the Leaside United Church's website from the middle of April and onward, 2021!

- 7. A signed permission form for media release (part of the Intention to Participate form) must be completed by each performer. The performer must submit both this Intention form and a video to take part in Virtual Variety Show 2021.
- 8. Our MC, will be asking for viewers to make a voluntary donation to a charity to generate funds for the city's most needy.
- 9. There will be a Launch Party of the Virtual Variety Show, together on Zoom, towards the middle of April. More details will be provided, to the performers, closer to that time.
